

DANCE IN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Dance In Leadership Scholarship Program is designed to reward long-time students of Elite Dance Academy, who have represented Elite values of Excellence, Leadership, Integrity, Teamwork, and Enthusiasm, while maintaining good academic achievement. Scholarships will be awarded to deserving seniors in high school who are current students of Elite Dance Academy, Inc. in good standing, based on eligibility and requirements set herein, at the discretion and final decision of the Director. Scholarship availability and amount awarded will be at the discretion of Elite Dance Academy, Inc. There are no guarantees of amount to be awarded.

The Selection Committee will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone. The Scholarship Committee may choose to interview applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified by June 1, 2018.

Guidelines for the Dance In Leadership Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors, currently enrolled in Elite Dance Academy, Inc. who plan to attend a college or university upon graduation. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name.

Student applicants should meet the following requirements:

- 1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college or university on a full time basis.
- 2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college of his/her choice and must plan to enroll as a full time student for Fall of the coming school year.
- 4. Must have attended Elite Dance Academy, Inc. for at least 4 consecutive years.
- 5. Must have been a member of the competition team for at least 3 of the last 4 years at Elite Dance Academy, Inc.
- 6. Must have an account in good standing with Elite Dance Academy, Inc, with no past due balances or outstanding fees.
- 7. Must not have excessive absences in enrolled classes at Elite Dance Academy, Inc,
- 8. Must have adhered to the studio policies and competition team policies consistently.
- 9. Must have shown leadership qualities and represented Elite Dance Academy, Inc. with good behavior both in and out of the studio.
- 10. Must have recommendations from at least 2 recent academic teachers, 1 dance instructor or staff member (excluding Director), and 2 unrelated persons who can speak to your character (may include a fellow dance student).
- 11. Essay on what dancing at Elite Dance Academy has meant in your life, how it's helped you develop leadership, and how this scholarship may help you.

Student applicants will receive special consideration for meeting the following, although not required to apply:

- Participated as a student assistant for at least one full season, with good attendance.
- 2. Student of Elite Dance Academy, Inc. for 10 or more years.
- 3. Documented Goals Sheet and Progress for last 4 dance seasons.

- 4. Participation in National Dance Week activities and local performances.
- 5. Participation in school clubs, organizations, community events.

Student applicant should note any special financial needs on their application form.

All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than May 16, 2018.
